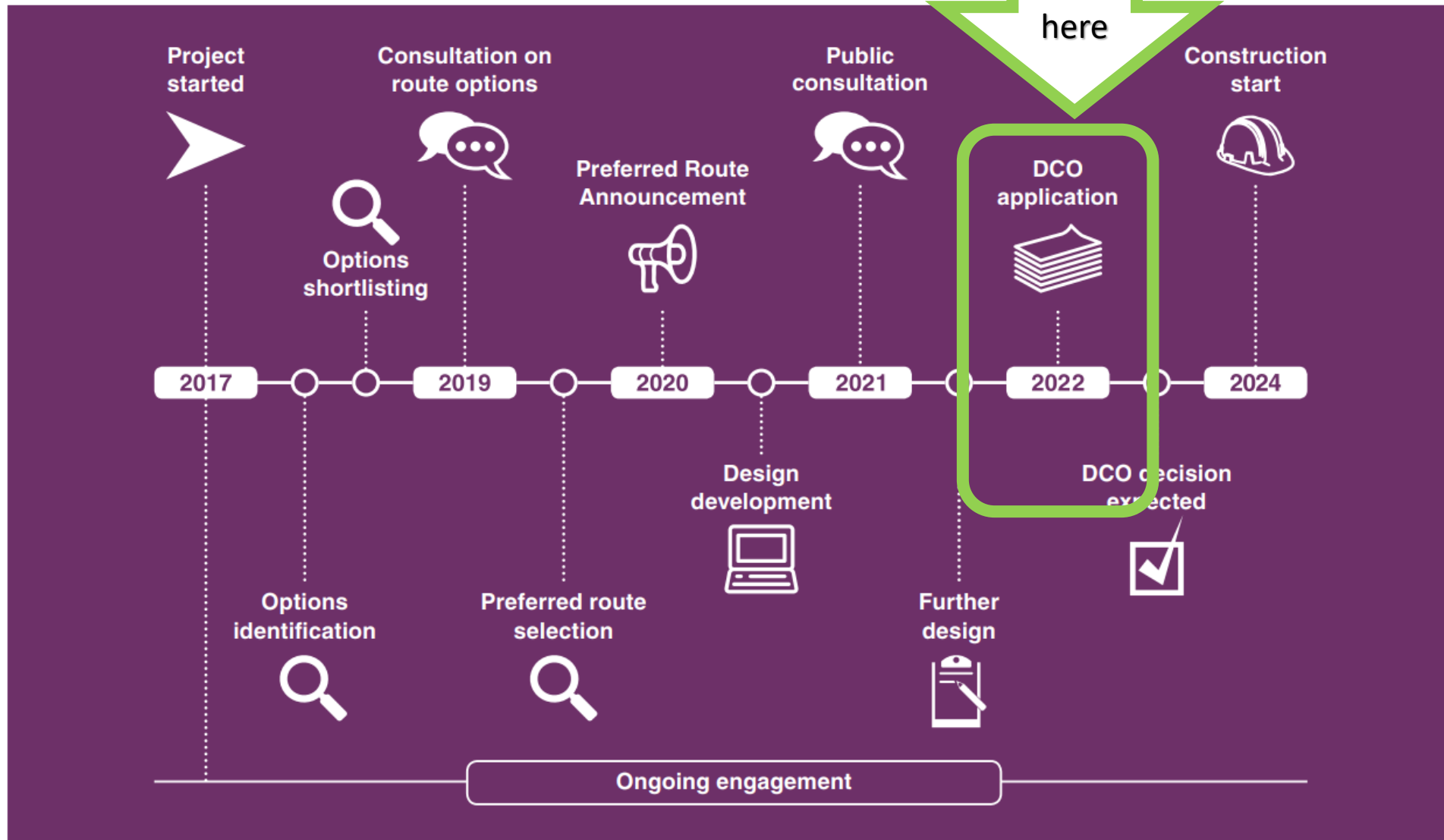

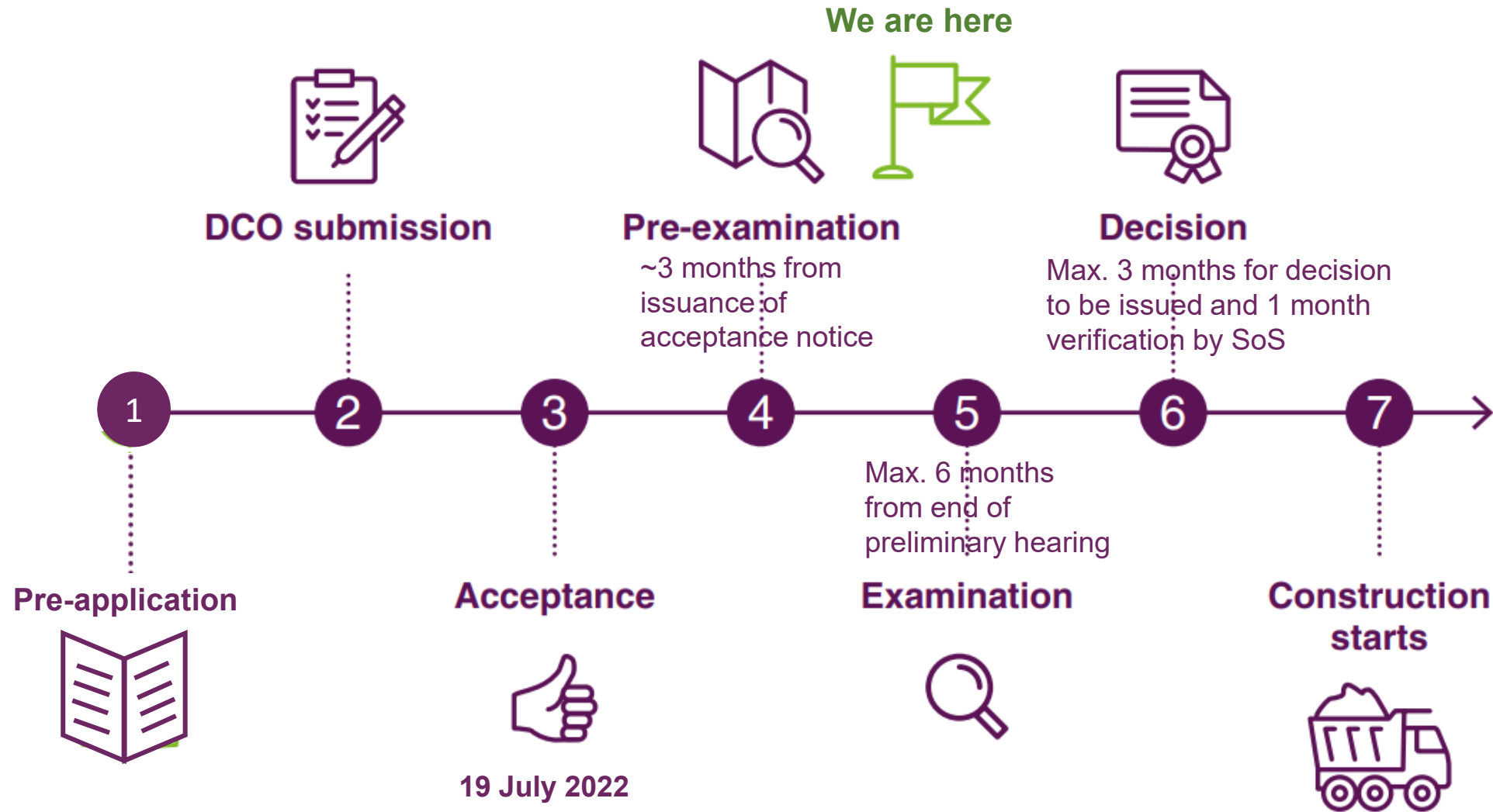

Project milestones since 2017



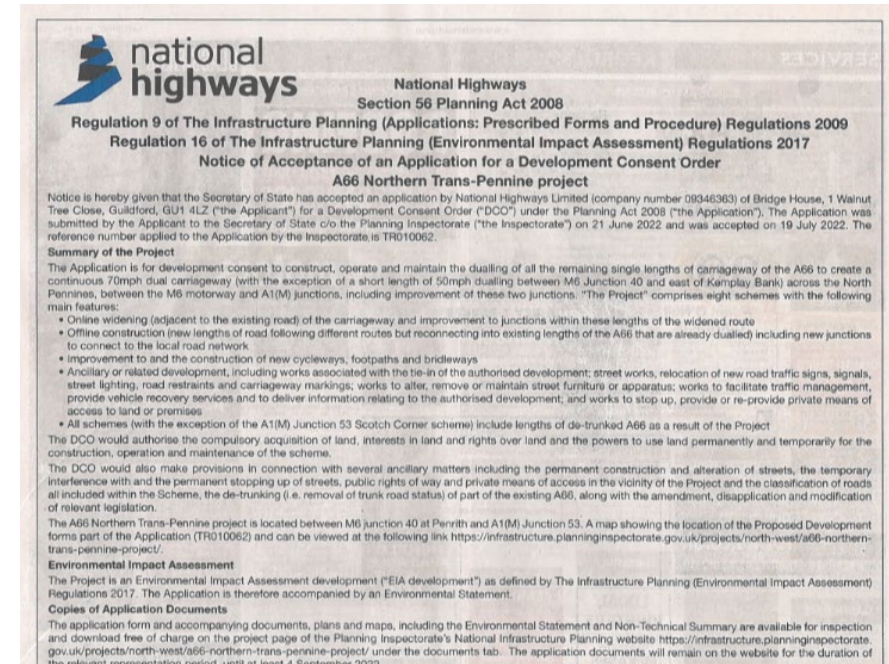
Where are we now – the application process



Notification to the public following Development Consent Order acceptance

Notification to public

- As required, National Highways as applicant has publicised that our development consent order application has been accepted by the Planning Inspectorate to move forwards to examination. We have informed the public about submitting relevant representations so they are received by the Planning Inspectorate by 4 September.
- National Highways informed the public by:
 - **S56 notices advertised** in Northern Echo, Darlington & Stockton Times, Cumberland & Westmoreland Herald, Evening Gazette in Teesside, Teesdale Mercury, Cumberland News (News & Star only), and the London Gazette and The Times.
 - **Awareness raising posters** - in public buildings and locations
 - **Letters** sent to prescribed consultees, local authorities and landowners
 - **Email** sent to focus groups, community liaison groups, other non-statutory stakeholders and members of the public
 - **Full hard copies** of the DCO documents are available at Penrith Library and Barnard Castle Library
 - **Site notices** are displayed over 36 locations along the route
 - Copies of the submission documents are also available on a **memory stick** and as **paper copy** on request

- b) Attend hearings during examination period

- Landowners, stakeholders and local community have been filling out form to become 'registered party' by the deadline
- They are providing summary representations to the Inspectorate
